ORDER

It is the ORDER of this Court that, in all proceedings where parties have consented to jurisdiction before a magistrate judge, the magistrate judge may, upon request, admit *pro hac vice* any attorney who is not a member of the Bar of this Court but who is admitted to practice before the United States District Court for the district (or before the highest court in the state) in which such attorney resides or regularly practices law. Any such attorney who appears as counsel by filing any pleading or paper in any case pending in this Court shall within ten days thereafter apply for admission *pro hac vice* as set out herein.
